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Privacy Policy

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), hereinafter referred to as the "GDPR", I hereby inform you that:

2) Personal data will be processed for the purpose of performing the contract for the provision of legal aid, covered by the order granted, in accordance with the principles listed in the GDPR and separate regulations, including the Law on Attorneys.

3) Personal data will be stored for the period required by separate regulations, including in particular the Law on the Bar and tax regulations.

4) Personal data may be transferred to employees employed by the Law Firm, as well as to lawyers cooperating with the Law Firm.

5) You have the right to access the previously provided data, receive a copy thereof, transfer the data, request deletion, rectification, restriction, object to their processing, lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.

6) Personal data will not be processed for direct marketing purposes.

7) Personal data will not be processed in an automated manner.

8) Providing your personal data is voluntary. Refusal to provide them

However, it prevents the provision of legal aid services.

9) You have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of the personal data provided. However, this does not affect the lawfulness of the processing that was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.

10) In matters related to the protection of personal data, the Administrator should be contacted in accordance with the data in point 1.
